Nostalgic evening purse with a tassle, it's the little things that make a difference.

MEASUREMENTS


YARN

Colour	Quantity
Jo Sharp Lumina x 50g balls	
810 Sin	2

Measurements given in inches are approximate.

Circumference - 44cm (17³/₈ in).

Depth - 25cm (9⁷/₈ in).



NEEDLES

1 pair 4.00mm needles (USA 6) (UK 8)

1 set 3.25mm double pointed needles (USA 3) (UK 10)

TENSION

22.5 sts and 30 rows measured over 10cm (approx 4 in) of St st using 4.00mm needles.

PURSE

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 100 sts. Work 8 rows St st.

Picot edge (RS) K1, *k2tog, yfon; rep from * to last st, K1.

Work in St st (beg with a P row) until length from beg measures 6cm, ending on a RS row.

Ridged eyelets Row 1 (WS) Knit.

Row 2 (RS) K1, *k2tog, yfon; rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 3 (WS) Knit.

Working in St st for rem (beg with a K row), work until length from beg measures 16cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape bag (RS) (dec) K1, *K2tog, K12; rep from * to last st, K1 [93 sts].

(WS) Purl.

(RS) (dec) K1, *K2tog, K11; rep from * to last 12 sts, K to end [114 sts].

Cont to dec 7 sts on foll alt rows as set (working 1 less st after dec's each time until 9 sts rem) [25 shaping rows].

(WS) Purl.

(RS) (dec) (K2tog) 4 times, K1 [5 sts].

Cut yarn, (leaving enough yarn to join seam), thread through rem sts, pull tight and secure.



MAKING UP

Using edge to edge st, sew seam.

Fold top edge of bag over along perforated picot edge. Slip st cast on edge of bag to inside, being careful not to show stitching on outside.

Drawstring Using 3.25mm double pointed needles, cast on 3 sts. *K3, do not turn work. Slide sts to right end of needle. Pull yarn to tighten. Rep from * until drawstring measures 100cm. Cast off, pull thread through rem st to secure and sew in ends.

Thread drawstring though ridged eyelets. Knot drawstring together approx 10cm from ends.

Tassle Wind yarn 40 times around a piece of cardboard 20cm long. Using a darning needle and yarn, slide needle under yarn at top, then tie to secure. Cut strands at bottom, then wrap a second piece of yarn around threads approx 2cm from top 5 times, tie securely. Trim ends to even length.

Using the thread at top of tassle, attach to bottom point of bag.
